Employment Services

Our Employment Services support the range of needs of individuals with disabilities to succeed in community employment. We work with employers to design jobs that are an individual match between the skills and abilities of an AtWork! client and a community employer in need of those skills. Many of our customized jobs are positions that did not exist until an AtWork! Employment Consultant worked with the employer to find tasks that their existing employees were already doing, or were not being done at all, that could be more efficiently done by an individual with a disability. We also provide support for individuals with disabilities to find and acquire regular jobs in a community business, and provide ongoing support to them on an as-needed basis. Our employers include Coinstar, Drugstore.com, Direct Interactions, Panera Bread, QFC, Walgreens, Dunn Lumber, Zeeks Pizza, Costco and more.

Community Inclusion Services

Community Inclusion Services support individuals with disabilities who are either of retirement age or not employed to be active in their community. Community Access Specialists support clients in volunteering, joining community groups, recreational opportunities, and other community involvement activities.

Transition Services

Transition Services are designed to help students with disabilities and their families determine future career paths in collaboration with teachers and advocates. Students explore their interests, talents and support needs followed by tours, volunteering and job shadowing. The goal is a job in the community by graduation day.

Commercial Services

AtWork! operates commercial services that provide a wide variety of job training and intership opportunities for the people we serve, as well as providing a source of income that supports our mission. These include a commercial landscaping business and a packaging and assembly shop that provides mailing services and hand packaging.
