Our fleet of eight sailboats, including Columbia 21s, Access dinghies and Martin 16s, are designed to accommodate a wide range of disabled sailors. We have two boats equipped with electronic controls and a mechanized transfer lift so that anyone can enjoy the freedom of sailing.
