Northwest's Child is a non-profit, after school, year-round, extended care program for school aged children and teens with moderate to severe developmental and physical disabilities. Our students range in age from 5 to 21 yrs. and our staff to student ratio is an average of 1:2.

Northwest's Child Edmonds is located in Lynnwood at Cypress Adventist School and serves students from all corners of the local school districts including Edmonds, Mukilteo, North Shore and Everett. Students enrolled in schools outside of the district we are located in can be transported via school bus or DART bus to our program after school. DART (Dial a Ride Transportation) is also commonly used by many of our families to transport our students home at the end of the day each day.



Our students, many of whom have challenges such as Cerebral Palsy, Downs Syndrome or Autism, work with our head teachers & assistants each day on a variety of skill areas such as Vocational training, Independent living, Social/emotional skills and Community Integration. We work closely with each students' IEP as well as their school teachers and parents in order to provide the best individual & group based programs for all.

Our program runs 12 months a year, 5 days a week. We operate a full day summer program as well as full days on "school out" days throughout the school year. Northwest's Child is a licensed agency with the DEL and able to use CSO funding.
