

The agency is qualified to provide residential care through these funding sources:

All sites provide 24-hour residential services, 365 days each year. Employees assist clients on an individualized basis with all aspects of daily living, self-care, food preparation, household cleaning, laundry, community shopping, appointments, socialization, and recreation. Caregivers meet all mandated state licensing training with annual updates.

Quilceda Community Services encourages client wellness with daily exercise, healthy meal planning, and social engagement. All residential sites have a small van available for community access and excursions. Tenants in the residential program lead active, individualized, and engaged lives.
