## What is Early Intervention?

Early intervention is a partnership between families and early childhood professionals.

Early intervention supports the growth, development and learning of children birth to three years of age with developmental delays or disabilities.

- ◆ Provide coordinated comprehensive, high quality services such as speech therapy, occupational and physical therapy, and education.
- ◆ Provide coaching and support to parents and caregivers to build upon family strengths.
- ◆ Enhance the development of children in everyday learning opportunities.
- ◆ Provide services in a natural learning environment including your:
  - ◆ Home
  - ◆ Child care
  - ◆ Neighborhood
  - ◆ Anywhere typically developing children live, learn and play

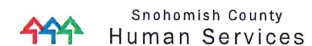
